This freshly renovated ground-floor apartment is located on a quiet side street in Porto Cristo – just 2 blocks from the beach – and features its own private entrance. Upon entering, you are welcomed by a bright living and dining area. From here, you access the separate "cold kitchen", ideal as an additional prep space with room for a small coffee setup. The main kitchen for daily cooking is located on the upper level and connected via a practical serving hatch.

The double bedroom is complemented by a separate sleeping nook with a bunk bed, offering flexible sleeping arrangements for guests or a small family. The bathroom presents itself in a modern style with a walk-in shower.

The heart of the apartment is the private patio – a sheltered outdoor area designed for relaxation. There's also a hot-water outdoor shower, perfect after a day at the beach. Cooking is done with gas bottles; an air-conditioning unit with heating and cooling ensures comfort throughout the year. A washing machine is also available. Shops, cafés, the harbor, and the beach are all within easy walking distance.

The apartment is rented on a seasonal basis; prices vary depending on the period. Detailed conditions are available upon request.


